

RESOLUTION NO. 88-3

WHEREAS, Section 8-19 of the Lexington City Code provides that electric rate charge schedules shall be set by resolution of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to establish a separate demand charge for seasonal irrigation service which is not interruptable.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, that the electric rate schedule applicable to seasonal irrigation service shall be amended to provide the following category:

For seasonal irrigation service which is not interruptable by the City of Lexington during peak demand periods shall be as follows:

- a) An annual demand charge of \$33.00 per horsepower payable prior to the commencement of the irrigation season;
- b) An energy charge of \$.0335 per kilowatt hour;

This rate shall take effect immediately for the 1988 irrigation season. Irrigators shall be presumed to be interruptable service unless they shall elect in writing, prior to the commencement of the irrigation season that they wish the service to be non-interruptable.
