

RESOLUTION NO. R1660

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:


Section 1. The Mayor and Council hereby find and determine that it is necessary and advisable that the City, under the authority granted by Section 18-2001 to 18-2003 inclusive, R.R.S. 1943, without petition or creating a district, cause the following unpaved street within the City to be improved by grading, and paving with integral curb, together with the pertinences, to-wit:

East Third Street from Fillmore Street to Taft Street,
which improvement shall be known as Street Improvement
Project No. 231G.

Section 2. It is further found and determined that the street to be improved in Street Improvement Project No. 231G is an unpaved portion, Six Hundred and Ninety Six Feet (696') in length, of an otherwise continuously paved street.

Section 3. The street improvements in Street Improvement Project No. 231G set out above, be, and the same are ordered constructed, and the City Engineer is directed to prepare plans and specifications and estimates of cost. For the purpose of constructing the above improvements, such improvements may be combined with other street improvement projects created in the City, but the actual cost of construction of each of the projects shall be performed in such manner that the costs may be allocated to each project for the purpose of levying any authorized special assessments.
