

RESOLUTION NO. R1692

WHEREAS, the City of Lexington is the proprietor of the Evergreen Cemetery, located east of Lexington; and

WHEREAS, Evergreen Cemetery has been in operation since 1879, and many of the gravesites are of pioneer families and are of historical interest.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the following sections of Evergreen Cemetery shall hereafter be designated as an area of historical interest and for pioneer graves only:

- All of Area A, containing lots numbered 1 through 44.
- That part of Area 1, containing lots numbered 17 through 60.
- That part of Area 2, containing lots numbered 61 through 104.
- That part of Area 3, containing lots numbered 137 through 180.
- That part of Area 4, containing lots numbered lots 181 through 224.

Section 2. That no further lots shall be sold in the above designated area, and burial permits granted only for lots previously sold.

Section 3. That appropriate markers shall be posted designating the above described area as a pioneer cemetery and an area of historical interest.
