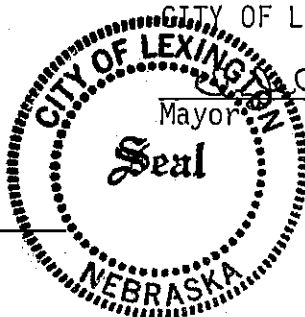

1. That the Lexington City Attorney is hereby directed and authorized on behalf of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, to institute necessary legal proceedings to foreclose the lien for Special Assessments in the following described districts and on the following described properties:

- A. Victor L. & Nancy Loose; Lot 50, Western Heights First Addition to the City of Lexington, Nebraska; Improvement District No. 209; Water Main District No. 12; Sewer District No. 80.
