

RESOLUTION NO. 91-16

WHEREAS, the City of Lexington, Nebraska, purposes to purchase and improve real estate for the purpose of a Grand Generation Center Building, and that such issue must first be placed before the electors of the City of Lexington, Nebraska; and

WHEREAS, the cost of purchase and improvement of such property at prevailing costs is \$498,000.00, of which cost \$300,000.00 is to be raised by imposition of a 1/2% City Sales Tax, and the balance to be paid through private or grant funds.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, that at a special election to be held on September 10, 1991, the following issue shall be submitted to all qualified electors within the corporate limits of the City of Lexington, Nebraska:

Shall the City of Lexington, Nebraska purchase the real estate described as the South One-Half (S 1/2) of Block Thirty-Nine (39), Original Town of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, said real estate to be remodeled and used as a Grand Generation Center for the City of Lexington, Nebraska?

A copy of this Resolution shall be immediately submitted to the County Clerk of Dawson County, Nebraska, for inclusion on the ballot at said special election.
