

RESOLUTION NO. 94-14

WHEREAS, Section 16-22 of the Lexington City Code authorizes the Council to designate the location of stop signs, and


WHEREAS, the Council finds that the public safety requires the placement of stop signs at the intersection of 15th Street and Freedom Lane.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, that the City Manager shall cause two-way stop signs to be placed at the intersection of 15th Street and Freedom Lane within the City, so as to stop traffic which is Eastbound and Westbound on 15th Street.


