

RESOLUTION 94- 21

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA that the members of the City Council, individually and collectively, hereby declare their intention to use any proceeds of the additional one-half percent (½%) city sales tax submitted to the voters on November 8, 1994 as follows:

or Proceeds
1. To apply to the cost of any capital improvements which are constructed for joint use with Lexington School District #1, including but not limited to gymnasium, media center, auditorium, or parking facilities.

2. To apply to the cost of a ~~new~~ swimming pool facility for the City of Lexington.

3. In the event that none of the above capital improvements are approved in separate bond issue elections within two years of the date that an additional one half percent (½%) city sales tax is first imposed, said additional sales tax will be ~~again~~ submitted to the voters for repeal.

Passed and approved this 11th day of October, 1994.




