


RESOLUTION 98-08


WHEREAS, the City of Lexington is considering closing grade crossings of the Union Pacific Railroad at Washington and Madison Streets, which will place additional traffic on the existing viaduct connecting Jackson Street and Plum Creek Parkway;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, that the State of Nebraska Department of Roads is hereby requested to change the traffic signs so as to prohibit left hand turns from Jackson Street onto 5th Street, and to prohibit left hand turns from Plum Creek Parkway onto Maple Street, both in the City of Lexington, Nebraska.
