

**RESOLUTION NO. 99-26**

WHEREAS, Nebraska Revised Statutes Section 77-1601.02 authorizes the governing body to set a final property tax request at a different amount than the property tax request for the prior year; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of Lexington, Nebraska has conducted a public hearing as prescribed by law and heard and considered comments concerning the propriety of the preliminary levy and the need to establish a different property tax request;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the Council of the City of Lexington, Nebraska hereby finds and determines that it is in the best interests of the Municipality that the property tax request be set at a different amount than that of the request for the previous year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, that the property tax request of the Municipality for the fiscal year 1999-2000 is set at Four Hundred Thirty Thousand and Eight Dollars (\$430,008.00).
