Passed and approved this 27th day of July 2004.

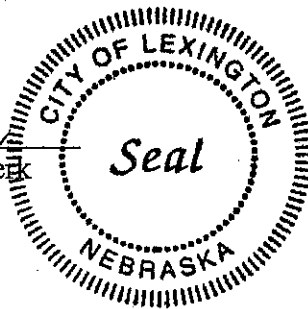


