

RESOLUTION 2015 - 06

WHEREAS, the City of Lexington, Nebraska and the Lexington Volunteer Fire Department have by Resolution 03-15, authorized and established a plan to charge and collect fees for the performance of fire and rescue services, and for the use of fire and rescue equipment; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Lexington, Nebraska and the Lexington Volunteer Fire Department to continue the established plan; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Neb. Rev. Stat. §19-646 (Rev. 2010), the City Manager shall perform such duties as may be required of him by Ordinance or Resolution of the Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined it would be in the best interests of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, to require the City Manager to set fees for fire and rescue services without the requirement of authorization from the City Council each year.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, that the established plan for charge and collection of fees for fire and rescue services, and for the use of fire and rescue equipment of the Lexington Volunteer Fire Department, is hereby authorized to continue.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that effective April 1, 2015, the fees collected for such services shall be according to a schedule of fees prepared by the City Manager. Such fees may be amended from time to time in the discretion of the City Manager but not less than annually.

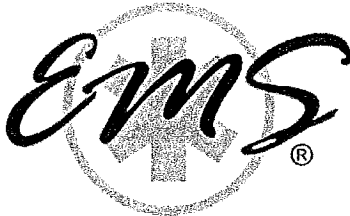
