CITY HALL LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA

March 1, 1938.

The Mayor and Council of the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, met in regular **special** session in the City Hall at 8:00 o'clock P. M., on March 1, 1938. Mayor Kjar presided and City Clerk Olsson recorded

the proceedings of this meeting.

The Mayor instructed the Clerk to call the roll. The Clerk called the roll and the following Councilmen were present: Gillan, Morganson, Hagadone, Morgan, Barrett.

Absent: Councilman Evans.

Whereupon the Mayor announced that the introduction of ordinances was now in order, and the matter now coming before the Mayor and Council was the passage and approval of Ordinance No. 334 of the City of Lexington, Nebraska.

This ordinance was introduced by Councilman Morgan and is in words and figures as follows, to wit:

ORDINANCE NO. 334.

An Ordinance to provide for the establishment in the City of Lexington, of a Municipal Inspection Station for motor vehicles, to provide for the purchase of necessary equipment, and acquire or lease the necessary building therefore, provide the fee to be charged for inspection, the employment and duties of an operator; to require the testing and inspection of all motor vehicles in the City of Lexington and to prohibit the operation of wehicles which have not been tested and approved, and to provide a penalty for the violation thereof.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

Sec. 1: There is hereby established in the City of Lexington, at such place as may be designated by the Mayor and Council of said City, a Municipal Inspection Station for the testing and inspection of motor vehicles having carrying capacity of $l\frac{1}{2}$ tons or less, and as provided by Section 60, Article 4 of the Compiled Statutes of Nebraska 1929, as amended.

Sec. 2: The necessary equipment which may be required for making the inspection of motor vehicles as required by the Laws of the State of Nebraska, shall be purchased by the City and installed in such building as may be acquired or leased by the Hayor and Council for that purpose.

Sec. 3: The standards for the inspection of motor vehicles and trailers shall be those fixed by the Statutes of the State of Mebraska, as amended, pertaining to brakes, lights and other equipment, and in addition such other and further standards as may be fixed by the director

of motor vehicles of the State of Mebraska, and such standards shall be strictly followed in the operation of the Lexington Inspection Station.

Sec. 4: A competent operator of such Inspection Station shall be appointed and employed by the Mayor, by and with the consent of the Council, at such salary as shall be fixed by the Mayor and Council at the time of his appointment. Such operator will be required to furnish bond to the City in the sum of \$500.00, for the faithful performance of his duties. He shall collect all inspection fees as hereinafter provided, and make remittance for all such fees to the City Treasurer at least once each week, and make a written monthly report to the Council of said City, on the first of each month, showing the number of vehicles inspected, the amount collected, and the amount of his remittances to the City Treasurer, the totals of which shall be carried forward on each subsequent report.

Sec. 5: Every resident owner of a motor vehicle or trailer in the City of Lexington, shall cause his vehicle to be inspected at the Municipal Station, herein established, at least once in each year, the first inspection period in the year of 1938, to be within the months of March, april, and May in said year and during the same period of each subsequent year, unless additional inspection may be required by the Laws of the State of Nebraska, in which event such additional inspection shall be required as may be hereafter provided by the Laws of Nebraska.

Sec. 6: An inspection fee of fifty (50) cents shall be charged for any one inspection, no additional charge shall be made for the second inspection of vehicles requiring corrective work if the original inspection has been made by the Station herein established and if within a reasonable period after such original inspection. Certificate of Inspection Stickers shall be furnished to such vehicles as fully meet the requirements of the Laws of Nebraska, relating to inspection and such other standards as the Director of Motor Vehicles of the State of Nebraska may be authorized to establish.

Sec. 7: It shall be unlawful for any person to drive or move, or for the owner to cause or knowingly permit to be driven or moved on any street within said City any motor vehicle or trailer without a Certificate of Inspection as provided for in Chapter 60, Article 4, Compiled Statutes of Nebraska, 1929, as amended, and any person who has violated any provision of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction therof shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$1.00 nor more than \$10.00 and shall be committed to jail until such fine and costs are paid.
