## ORDINANCE NO. 357 ANNUAL APPROPRIATION BILL

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That there is hereby appropriated out of money to be raised by general levy of taxes upon all property within the City of Lexington, Nebraska, and of money now on hand and money to be received from collection of water rent and money to be received from the County for road fund, for the purpose of paying present liabilities, current expenses, and for necessary improvements and expenses of said City for the fiscal year 1939, the following sums of money, to-wit:
