**ORDINANCE NO. 370
ANNUAL LEVY ORDINANCE**

An ordinance making a levy for taxation on all of the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, for the fiscal year 1942, commencing on the first Tuesday in May, 1942.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That there is hereby levied on all of the taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, for the fiscal year 1942, commencing on the First Tuesday of May, 1942, the following:
