

ORDINANCE NO. 597

An Ordinance to repeal that part of Section 2 of Article II of Chapter 11 of the Occupation Tax Ordinance of the City of Lexington which was passed and approved on April 7, 1943, and which levies an occupation tax upon card tables used in card rooms.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA.


Section 1. All that part of Section 2 of Article II of Chapter 11 of the Municipal Code of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, providing for the levy of an occupation tax on the following described occupation:

"Card rooms, for each card table used therein but not to be used for gambling purposes under any pretext, whatsoever, or for any card table kept in any place of business and operated for hire, profit or gain, subject to the above conditions, first table, per year \$10.00.

Same, each additional table, per year \$5.00";


