ORDINANCE NO. 67/

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 1, ARTICLE V, CHAPTER 5, AND SECTION 1, ARTICLE VI, CHAPTER 5 AND TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That Section 1, Article V, Chapter 5 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. FIREWORKS, POSSESSION ETC, UNLAWFUL, WHEN.—
That it shall hereafter be unlawful for any person, persons, firm or corporation to have possession of either for sale or for any other purpose, to offer for sale, or to use, within said City, any fireworks of any kind, excepting, however, from the provisions hereof, the display of fireworks as provided in Section 2 hereof and further excepting sparklers, we suvius fountains, spray fountains, torches, color fire cones, star and comet type color aerial shells without explosive charge for the purpose of making a noise, color wheels, toy cap pistols, and toy caps each of which does not contain more than twenty-five hundredths of a gram of explosive material. Such fireworks shall be used, or sold at retail, only between June 27 and July 5 of each year."

Section 2. That Section 1, Article VI, Chapter 5, of the Municipal Code of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. VIOLATION, PENALTY.—That any person, persons, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Chapter shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction thereof shall be fined in a sum not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) and shall be committed to the City Jail until such fine and costs of prosecution are fully paid."

Section 3. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict hereof be and the same are hereby repealed. Passed and approved this 21st day of July, 1953.
