ordinance no. 683

AN ORDINANCE CREATING PAVING DISTRICT NUMBER 7, AND PROVIDING FOR CURB AND GUTTER, GRADING, DRAINAGE AND PAVING THEREIN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That there is hereby created within said city, a paving district, to be known as "Paving District No. 7."

Section 2. Said Paving District shall consist of that part of Jackson Street from Pacific Avenue North to a line from the Southeast corner of Lot Fifty-one (51) Woodlawn Addition in the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, to the Southwest corner of Lot Fifty-two (52) of the said Woodlawn Addition;

and

That part of Woodlawn Avenue North and Northwest from the South boundary line of Lot Sixteen (16), Woodlawn Addition in the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, extended East to Lot One (1), East Woodlawn Addition in the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, to a line extended from the Southeast corner of Lot Fifty-one (51), Woodlawn Addition in the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, to the Southwest Corner of Lot Fifty-two (52) of the said Woodlawn Addition;

and

Seventh Street from Grant Street to Jackson Street; that said streets will abut on pavement already laid.

Section 3. That there shall be constructed and provided on said portion of streets, paving, curb, gutter and drainage as needed; that the paving, curbing, guttering, and drainage shall be in accordance with plans, specifications and estimates to be hereafter adopted.

Section 4. That the cost of such paving, curbing, guttering and drainage, except street and alley intersections, shall be assessed against the lots and tracts of land abutting said portion of streets, specifically benefited thereby, in proportion to the benefits received, to be determined by the City Council as provided by law.
