

ORDINANCE NO. 694

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A STREET BEGINNING ON WASHINGTON STREET AND RUNNING IN A SOUTHEASTERLY DIRECTION THROUGH TRACT K OF THE SUBDIVISION OF SECTION FIVE, TOWNSHIP NINE, RANGE TWENTY-ONE, WEST OF THE 6TH P.M. IN THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA, TO BRIDGE STREET, ALL IN THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA, AND TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That the Street beginning on Washington Street and running in a Southeasterly direction through Tract K of the Subdivision of Section Five (5), Township Nine (9), Range Twenty-one (21), West of the 6th P.M. in the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, to Bridge Street, all in the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, shall be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2. All Ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.
