ORDINANCE NO. 736

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING A RIGHT OF WAY AND AN EASEMENT ACROSS LOT FOUR (4), BOWENS FIRST ADDITION IN THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA, OWNED BY THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, TO THE STATE OF NEBRASKA, FOR A ROADWAY FOR THE USE OF THE MILITARY DEPARTMENT—NEBRASKA NATIONAL GUARD—ONLY PURSUANT TO SECTION 18-1004, REVISED STATUTES OF NEBRASKA, 1943

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA:

Section 1.

The City of Lexington, being the owners of Lot Four (4), Bowens First Addition in the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, do hereby give the said State of Nebraska, a right of way and an easement of the East Twenty-Four (24) Feet of the West Thirty-Two (32) Feet of the said Lot Four (4) for use as a roadway.

Section 2.

The President of the Council and the City Clerk of the City of Lexington Nebraska, are hereby authorized and directed to execute and acknowledge on behalf of said City a right of way deed conveying the said easement acress the said real estate to the said grantee for the purposes herein set forth.

Section 3.

That upon the termination by the State of Nebraska, of the use thereof, specified in Section 1 hereof, said real estate shall immediately revert to the City of Lexington, Nebraska, provided however, that the said grantee may remove any improvements placed thereon by it.

Section 4.

This ordinance shall be in force and effect after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
