AN ORDINANCE CREATING AND NAMING A STREET BEGINNING AT THE SOUTH BOUNDARY LINE OF 6th STREET AT THE INTERSECTION OF 6th STREET AND FILLMORE STREET RUNNING THENCE SOUTH ONE HUNDRED FORTY (140) FEET TO AN ALLEY RUNNING PERPENDICULAR THERETO IN THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA.

Section 1. That the following described real estate is hereby created and declared to be a street in Lexington, Nebraska, and is named Fillmore Street.

Commencing at a point Three Hundred Eighty (380) feet East of the Northeast Corner of Block Sixteen (16), in MacColl and Leflang's Third Addition to the Original Town of Plum Creek, Now City of Lexington; thence East Eighty (80) feet; thence South One Hundred Forty (140) feet; thence West Eighty (80) feet; thence North One Hundred Forty (140) feet to the place of beginning.

Section 2. That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
