## ORDINANCE NO. 795

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF A STREET LOCATED BETWEEN BLOCK X, UNION PACIFIC ADDITION AND THE UNION PACIFIC RIGHT OF WAY, CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA, AND TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. That that part of Pacific Avenue lying between the west line of Washington Street and the East line of Lincoln Street and more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of the west line of Washington Street in the City of Lexington, Nebraska, with the North line of the Right-of-Way of the Union Pacific Railroad Company, thence northwesterly along the North line of said Union Pacific Railroad Company Right-of-Way to the East line of Lincoln Street; thence North along the East line of Lincoln Street a distance of Fifteen (15) feet; thence Southeasterly on a line parallel with and Fifteen (15) feet distant from said North line of the Union Pacific Railroad Company Right-of-Way, to the West line of Washington Street; thence South along the West line of Washington Street to the place of beginning,

all being located in the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, shall be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.
