

ORDINANCE NO. 1662

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 5-17 OF THE LEXINGTON CITY CODE, INCREASING THE IMPOUNDMENT FEE FOR DOGS AND CATS; TO REPEAL ORIGINAL CODE SECTION 5-17; TO PROVIDE FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. Code Section 5-17 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 5-17. Same -- Reclaiming by owner.

Within three (3) days after notice is given or mailed as provided in Section 5-16, the owner of any such impounded animal may claim such animal by paying the following:

(a) First redemption of a dog or cat within a calendar year, \$15.00 for a dog which is licensed and \$25.00 for an unlicensed dog or cat, plus the cost of any medical care expended by the City for such impounded animal and any license tax that may be due.

(b) A second or any subsequent redemption of the same dog or cat within a calendar year, \$15.00 for a licensed dog and \$25.00 for an unlicensed dog or cat, plus the cost of any medical care expended by the City for such impounded animal and any license tax that may be due, plus prosecution under appropriate ordinances.

Section 2. That original Section 5-17 is hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect as provided by law.
