ORDINANCE NO. 1751

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 16-41 OF THE LEXINGTON CITY CODE; TO PROVIDE FOR A REDUCED SPEED LIMIT ON WEST 13th STREET FROM ERIE STREET TO THE WEST CITY LIMITS; TO REPEAL ORIGINAL SECTION 16-41; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 16-41 of the Lexington City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 16-41. Same--Other specific speed limits.

(a) The speed limit shall be thirty miles per hour on the following streets or parts of streets:

Bridge Street and Jackson Street, Maple to Fifth Street.

Fifth Street, Grant to Jefferson.

Grant Street, Fifth Street to Pacific Avenue.

Jefferson Street, Pacific Avenue to Fifth Street.

(b) The speed limit shall be thirty-five miles per hour on the following streets or parts of streets:

Adams Street, from Drainage District No. 1 drainage ditch to Oak Street, and U. S. Highway 30 to the City Limits North of 20th Street.

Pacific Avenue, mid-block between Madison Street and Lincoln Street to the City limits West of Erie Street.

Pacific Avenue, Taft Street to Jackson Street.

Taft Street, Pacific Avenue to 13th Street.

East 13th Street, Fillmore East to the City limits.

West Walnut Street, Adams Street West to the City limits.

East Walnut Street, Bridge Street East to the City limits.

(c) The speed limit shall be forty miles per hour on the following street or part of street:

Bridge Street, Maple to south City limits.

Section 2. That original Section 16-41 and all other ordinances or sections of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect as provided by law.
