

ORDINANCE NO. 1775

AN ORDINANCE CREATING STREET IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 234, AND PROVIDING FOR THE PAVING OF SOUTH ADAMS STREET FROM WALNUT STREET TO SOUTH CITY LIMITS, AND WEST WALNUT STREET FROM ADAMS STREET TO WEST CITY LIMITS; TO PROVIDE FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES OR SECTIONS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; TO PROVIDE FOR PUBLICATION AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby created within the City a Street Improvement District as provided for by Section 16-617, R.R.S. 1943, to be known as Street Improvement District No. 234, consisting of property described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at a point on the North Right-of-Way line of West Walnut Street, which is One Hundred Fifty Feet (150') West of the Southwest Corner of Block Six (6), C. L. Ervin's Subdivision; Thence North One Hundred Fifty Feet (150') Feet; Thence East and parallel to the Right-of-Way of West Walnut Street to the center line of South Adams Street; Thence South to the intersection of South Adams and West Walnut Streets; Thence East and along the center line of West Walnut Street to a point which is One Hundred Fifty Feet (150') East of the East Right-of-Way line of South Adams Street; Thence South and parallel to South Adams Street to a point on the North line of Dawson County Drainage District No. 1 Right-of-Way; Thence West to the center line of South Adams Street, which is the East line of Section Seven (7), Township Nine (9) North, Range Twenty-One (21) West of the 6th P. M.; Thence North along said East Section line of said Section Seven (7) to the Northeast Corner of said Section Seven (7); Thence West along the North Section line of said Section Seven (7) to a point One Hundred Fifty Feet (150') West of the West line extended of Block Six (6), C. L. Ervin's Subdivision; Thence North to the point of beginning.

Section 2. That street improvements shall be constructed on West Walnut Street from Adams Street to the corporate limits, and on South Adams Street from Walnut Street South to the corporate limits by paving with recycled asphaltic concrete paving.

Section 3. That the cost of such paving as determined by the City Council, sitting as a board of equalization, shall be levied as special assessments against the property within the District.

Section 4. That all ordinances or sections of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. That this Ordinance shall be published in a legal newspaper in the City of Lexington for one (1) time each week for not less than twenty (20) days, and shall take effect twenty (20) days after the first such publication.
