ORDINANCE NO. 1842

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE USE OF LEAD PIPE, SOLDER AND FLUX WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY; TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES OR SECTIONS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM.

WHEREAS, LB 383 adopted by the Nebraska Legislature provides that the operator of a public water supply system shall prohibit the use of lead pipe, solder or flux in any facility connected to the public water supply system; therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Building Regulations Prohibition of Lead Pipes, Solder, and Flux.

Any pipe, solders or flux used in the installation or repair of any residential or non-residential facility which is connected to the public water supply system shall be lead free.

For purposes of this section, lead free shall mean:

- 1) Solders and flux - not more than two-tenths of one percent (.2%) lead, and
- 2) Pipe and pipe fittings - not more than eight percent (8%) lead.

Section 2. That all other ordinances or sections of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect as provided by law.
