ORDINANCE NO. 1861

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE WATER EXTENSION DISTRICT NO. 89-1 ;  
TO PROVIDE THE BOUNDARIES OF SUCH DISTRICT, THE DESCRIPTION AND  
LOCATION OF WATER MAINS, AND THE OUTER BOUNDARIES OF SAID DIS-  
TRICT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXI-  
NGTON, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That it is deemed necessary and advisable for the City  
of Lexington to construct water mains which extend into newly an-  
nexed areas of the City of Lexington, from existing water mains,  
and therefore Water Extension District No. 89-1 is hereby  
created.

2. That the improvements to be constructed within said dis-  
trict are twelve inch (12") water mains, together with steel  
casing under U. S. Highway No. 283 for connection with other  
water mains; that said water main will commence at the intersec-  
tion of Ash Street and U. S. Highway No. 283, and shall extend  
along Highway No. 283 right-of-way to its point of termination at  
the Wal-Mart Subdivision.

3. That plans and specifications for said water main  
project, heretofore filed with the office of the Lexington City  
Clerk, are hereby approved, and the City engineer's cost es-  
timate of \$ 170,000 is hereby accepted.

4. That the boundaries of the Water Extension District No. 89-1 are as follows:

A Tract of land in the West One-Half (West 1/2) of Section Eight (8), Township Nine (9) North, Range Twenty-One (21) West of the 6th P.M., and within the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, which includes the following:

- a) All of D-I-C Addition to the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska.
- b) A tract of land six hundred feet (600') in width, parallel to and abutting the United States Highway No. 283 right-of-way, from the North right-of-way line of Drainage District No. 1, to the North right-of-way line of Wal-Mart Subdivision, a subdivision of the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska.

5. That the cost of construction of such water extension district shall be assessed against property within the district, according to the extent of special benefit, and the City of Lexington shall adopt further rules and regulations governing the time and manner of connections to said water main extension.

6. That this ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect as provided by law.
