ORDINANCE NO. 1896

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING A SPECIAL ASSESSMENT UPON THE LOTS, PARTS OF LOTS, LANDS AND REAL ESTATE SPECIALLY BENEFITTED BY THE IMPROVEMENTS IN WATER EXTENSION DISTRICT NO. 89-1, OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA; TO DEFRAY THE COSTS OF SAID IMPROVEMENTS TO THE EXTENT OF THE SPECIAL BENEFIT TO SUCH LOTS, PARTS OF LOTS, LANDS AND REAL ESTATE BY REASON OF SUCH IMPROVEMENTS AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM.

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the City Council sitting as a Board of Equalization, after publication and notice to property owners as required by law, that the benefit to the lots, parts of lots, lands and real estate in Water Extension District No. 89-1 for construction of water main extensions within the Water Extension District are equal and uniform in proportion to the various lots, parts of lots, lands, and real estate in said District.

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. There is hereby levied against the lots, parts of lots, lands, and real estate within and specially benefitted by improvements in Water Extension District No. 89-1, a special tax of \$14,516.06 to pay the costs of improvements in the District, to be apportioned among the lots, parts of lots, lands and real estate, according to front footage of real estate abutting the water main and according to rules which the Board of



SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect as provided by law.
