ORDINANCE NO. 191~~4~~

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA, REVISING ALL THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY, THEREBY ADOPTING A REVISED CITY CODE WHICH SHALL COMPLETELY SUPERSEDE THE MUNICIPAL CODE ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE NUMBER 1206 ON MAY 26, 1970; TO AUTHORIZE THE PUBLICATION THEREOF IN BOOK FORM; TO PRESCRIBE AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That all ordinances of a general and permanent nature comprising the MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA are hereby revised, compiled, codified and authorized to be published in book form as attached hereto, with table of contents and index, under the direction and by authority of the president of the council and council of said city.

SECTION 2. Such revision shall be classified under thirty-two (32) chapters entitled:

SECTION 3. In construing the provisions of this ordinance, the following ordinances shall not be deemed or held to be ordinances of a general or permanent nature, to-wit:

Ordinances pertaining to fiscal management, vacating streets or alleys, authorizing or directing public improvements, levying taxes or special assessments, annual budgets, granting franchises, or any ordinance which by its nature would be considered special.

SECTION 4. Each chapter and section hereof is hereby declared to be independent of every other chapter or section, and the invalidity of any chapter or section of this ordinance shall not invalidate any other chapter or section.

SECTION 5. That this ordinance shall be cited as Lexington City Code, revision 1990.

SECTION 6. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 7. The repeal of ordinances as provided in section 6 hereof shall not affect any rights, fines, penalties, forfeitures or liabilities incurred or acquired thereunder, or actions involving any of the provisions of such ordinances, or any part thereof, and said ordinances are hereby continued in full force and effect after the passage, approval and publication of this revision for the purpose of such rights, fines, penalties, forfeitures and liabilities or actions thereunder.

SECTION 8. This revision ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publications as provided by law.
