ORDINANCE NO. 1954

AN ORDINANCE CREATING IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 92-1, PROVIDING FOR GRADING AND CONCRETE PAVING THEREIN; PROVIDING AND EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. There is hereby created within the City of Lexington, an Improvement District to be known as "Improvement District No. 92- 1".

Section 2. The Improvement District shall consist of the following real estate in the City of Lexington, Nebraska:

The West one-half of Block Two (2), MacColl's Addition; and the East One Hundred fifty feet (E. 150') of Tract C of the Subdivision of Section 6-9-21, all in the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska;

Section 3. There shall be constructed and provided on the above described real estate, grading and paving along Lake Street from its intersection with 10th Street to its intersection with 9th Street, which shall be in accordance with the plans, specifications, and estimates to be hereinafter adopted.

Section 4. The street provided in the above section will abut on curb and gutter where it exists, and may include curb and gutter where curb and gutter has not already been provided.

Section 5. That the cost of such grading and paving, excluding street and alley intersections, shall be assessed against lots and tracts of land abutting upon and adjacent to said portion of the streets, specifically benefited thereby, in proportion to the benefit received, to be determined by the City Council as the law provides.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect as provided by law.
