

ORDINANCE NO. 1969

CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA

AN ORDINANCE TO IMPOSE AN EMERGENCY TELEPHONE CHARGE UPON LOCAL EXCHANGE ACCESS LINES WITHIN THE CITY OF LEXINGTON; TO AUTHORIZE SERVICE SUPPLIERS TO COLLECT SAID EMERGENCY TELEPHONE CHARGES; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA FOR OPERATION OF AN EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SERVICE SYSTEM FOR THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA. TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM.

1. There is hereby imposed, pursuant to Nebraska Revised Statutes Sections 86-1001, et sequentor (RS Supp. 1992) upon all telephone exchange access lines within the City of Lexington, Nebraska an emergency telephone charge in the amount of \$.50 per month on each local exchange access line physically terminating within the corporate limits of the City of Lexington.
2. Telephone service suppliers providing telephone service within the City of Lexington are hereby authorized to collect the emergency telephone charge authorized by this Ordinance.
3. The Mayor of the City of Lexington is hereby directed and authorized to sign on behalf of the City of Lexington, an Interlocal Agreement with the County of Dawson, Nebraska for operation of an enhanced 911 service for the "324" telephone exchange area, and providing

that the service surcharge heretofore imposed upon telephone exchange access lines within the City of Lexington shall be paid to and collected by the Dawson County Treasurer.

4. This Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect as provided by law.
