ORDINANCE NO. 1982

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTIONS 16-21 OF THE LEXINGTON CITY CODE; TO DESIGNATE MADISON STREET SOUTH OF HIGHWAY 30 AS A THROUGH STREET; TO REPEAL ORIGINAL SECTION 16-21, AND ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR SECTIONS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 16-1 of the Lexington City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 16-21 Through Streets--Designated.

Those streets and parts of streets described in this section are hereby declared to be through streets for the purpose of this chapter:


(a) Primary arterials.
Pacific Avenue
Washington Street

(b) Arterials.
Adams Street
Bridge Street
Fifth Street, Washington Street to Highway No. 30
Grant Street, Thirteenth Street to Pacific Avenue
Lincoln Street, Thirteenth Street to Pacific Avenue
Madison Street, Pacific Avenue to Oregon Trail Road
Sixth Street, Washington Street to east city limits
Thirteenth Street
Walnut Street.

Section 3. That original § 16-21, together with all ordinances or sections of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


Section 4. That this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect as provided by law.
