

ORDINANCE NO. 2060

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 1-7 OF THE LEXINGTON CITY CODE; TO INCREASE THE MAXIMUM FINE FOR VIOLATION OF THE CITY CODE; TO REPEAL ORIGINAL SECTION 1-7 AND ANY ORDINANCES OR SECTIONS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; AND TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 1-7 of the Lexington City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 1-7 General Penalty; Continuing Violations.

Any person who shall violate, neglect or refuse to comply or who resists or opposes the enforcement of, any of the provisions of this Code shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof, shall be fined in any sum not more than five hundred dollars for each offense or shall be imprisoned in jail for a period not to exceed thirty days, or both such fine and imprisonment. Such person so fined shall stand committed to jail until such fine and costs of prosecutions are fully paid. Every day on which such violation, neglect or refusal shall continue, shall be deemed as a separate and distinct offense.

Section 2. That original Section 1-7 and all other ordinances or sections of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect as provided by law.
