

ORDINANCE NO. 2077

**AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE A PORTION OF THIRD STREET LYING WEST OF JACKSON STREET; TO PROVIDE FOR REVERSION OF THE VACATED STREET TO ADJOINING PROPERTY OWNERS; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That it is in the best interest of the municipality that a portion of Third Street lying west of Jackson Street be privately owned and maintained by the adjoining business owners, and that a portion of such street be vacated.

Section 2. That the City of Lexington, Nebraska hereby vacates that portion of East Third Street lying west of Jackson Street and located between Pacific Avenue on the south and Lots 23 and 24 of Block 72, Original Town of Plum Creek, now City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska.

Section 3. That the vacated street right-of-way shall revert to the adjoining owners of said Lots 23 and 24, Original Town of Plum Creek, now City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect as provided by law.
