

ORDINANCE NO. 2122

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 3-6 OF THE LEXINGTON CITY CODE; TO PROVIDE FOR SUNDAY SALES OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE PREMISES; TO REPEAL ORIGINAL SECTION 3-6, AND ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR SECTIONS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 3-6 of the Lexington City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 3-6 Hours of Sale Generally.

- (a) No alcoholic liquors shall be sold at retail or dispensed on the first day of the week, commonly called Sunday, or on Thanksgiving Day or Christmas, between the hours of 1:00 A.M. and 1:00 A.M. the day following, provided, that alcoholic liquor including beer and wine may be sold or dispensed for off-premises consumption, on the first day of the week, commonly called Sunday, or on Thanksgiving Day or Christmas, between the hours of 6:00 A.M. and 1:00 A.M. the day following, and provided further, that alcoholic liquor including beer and wine may be sold or dispensed for on-premises consumption, on the first day of the week, commonly called Sunday, or on Thanksgiving Day or Christmas, between the hours of 12:00 noon and 1:00 A.M. the day following.
- (b) No alcoholic liquors, including beer, shall be sold at retail or dispensed on secular days between 1:00 A.M. and 6:00 A.M.

Section 2. That original Section 3-6, together with all ordinances or sections of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect as provided by law.
