

ORDINANCE NO. 2269

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE THAT PORTION OF SOUTH LINCOLN STREET LYING BETWEEN WEST MAPLE STREET AND WEST WALNUT STREET; TO PROVIDE FOR REVERSION OF THE VACATED STREET TO ADJOINING PROPERTY OWNERS; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That it is in the best interest of the municipality that a portion of South Lincoln Street lying between West Maple Street and West Walnut Street be privately owned and maintained by the adjoining owners, and that such portion of street should be vacated.

Section 2. That the City of Lexington, Nebraska hereby vacates that portion of South Lincoln Street lying between West Maple Street and West Walnut Street.

Section 3. That the vacated street right-of-way shall revert to the adjoining owners of South Ward School Block of the Subdivision of Section 5-9-21 in the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska to the West, and the West one-half of Lot 7, and the West one-half of Parts A and B of Lot 8, and the West One-half of Lot 9, all Tract "L" of the Subdivision of Section 5-9-21 in the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect as provided by law.
