A Special Meeting of the Lexington City Council was held Wednesday, May 1, 2002, at the Lexington Municipal Building, located at 406 E. 7<sup>th</sup> Street, Lexington, Nebraska at 7:00 a.m. Members of the Council present were Mayor John Fagot, Ted Cook, Rick Klamm, and John Salem. Councilman Tomasek was absent. City Officials present were City Manager Joe Peplitsch, City Attorney Willard Weinhold, Deputy City Clerk Shirley Lewis.

**NOTICE:** Notice of the meeting was given in advance, thereof by publication in the Lexington Clipper-Herald, the designated method for giving notice, as shown by the Affidavit of Publication attached to these Minutes. Notice of this meeting was simultaneously given to the Mayor and all members of the Council, and a copy of their Acknowledgement of Receipt of Notice and the Agenda is attached to these Minutes. Availability of the Agenda was communicated in advance notice and in the notice to the Mayor and Council of this Meeting. The proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public. All items presented and discussed on the Agenda were available for public inspection.

**CALL TO ORDER:** The meeting was called to order by Mayor Fagot.

**PAY REQUEST:** Peplitsch addressed the City Council requesting approval of Pay Request Number 1 for Municipal Wells No. 17 and No. 18, to Lieh's Drilling. Following discussion, moved by Cook, seconded by Klamm, to approve Pay Request Number 1 for Municipal Wells No. 17 and No. 18. Roll call. Voting "aye" were Salem, Klamm, Cook, Fagot. Motion carried.

**PUBLIC HEARING:** Mayor Fagot opened the Public Hearing. Peplitsch addressed the City Council, reviewing with them the Blight and Substandard Determination Study performed by Hanna/Keelan on Redevelopment Area #4. Following Peplitsch's presentation, Mayor Fagot closed the Public Hearing. No further action was taken.

**RESOLUTION:** The Council will bring the Resolution back for consideration at the next City Council Meeting scheduled for May 13, 2002.

**ADJOURNMENT:** There being no further business to come before the Council, Mayor Fagot declared the meeting adjourned.
