

the sidewalk is found to be in such dilapidated or dangerous condition, the same shall, by the City Manager, be at once condemned, and the City Manager shall cause employees of the City to remove such condemned sidewalk. (Mun. Code, Sec. 10-405)

Sec. 24-15 Duty to Replace Condemned Sidewalk.

Where sidewalks are condemned and ordered removed, it shall be the duty of the owner or person having charge or control of the premises abutting on the street where the sidewalk was, to construct or cause to be constructed, a concrete sidewalk as provided for in this article, and the sidewalk shall be built within sixty days, unless prevented by snow, rain or cold, after the sidewalk shall have been condemned, and notice of the condemnation and to construct the new sidewalk given to the owner or person having the premises in charge. Such notice shall be given by the City Manager and attested by the City Clerk-Treasurer and served either personally in writing or by publishing once in a weekly newspaper of general circulation, published in the City. (Mun. Code, Sec. 10-405.01)

Sec. 24-16 Curbing.

At the time of the construction of walks provided for by this article, on Washington Street, and within the fire limits of the City, there shall be constructed along the outer edge of the City sidewalks curbing of cement concrete not less than four inches thick and not less than fifteen inches deep, and the same shall be placed in uniform manner along the sidewalk. (Mun. Code, Sec. 10-406)

Sec. 24-17 When Construction Required.

Sidewalks to be constructed as provided by this article may be ordered by the City Council at any time to be laid where sidewalks have not before existed, or where sidewalks have been condemned, or defective or unsafe walks ordered to be repaired by the City Council, by a three-fourths vote thereof. Sidewalks shall be ordered by the City Council when petitioned for by a majority of the resident owners of property abutting on the proposed walk, when no sidewalk exists or when sidewalks have been condemned, and notice of such order shall be served upon the owner or persons having charge of the premises abutting on the proposed walk, in the manner provided for in this article, and in case of the failure of such owner or person having the premises in charge, to build or repair the walk as so ordered, it may proceed to rebuild or repair the walk and assess the cost thereof upon the property abutting thereon in the manner provided by the laws of the state. (Mun. Code, Sec. 10-407)

Sec. 24-18 Removal of Snow.
