

Description of Premises. The Landlord leases to Tenant the property at 405 East 1. Pacific, Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska.

The Lease shall include all furniture, fixtures and other personal property located on the premises. A list of said items is attached as Exhibit "A" hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

- Term. The term of this Lease shall be for two (2) years and three (3) months commencing February 1, 2008, or as soon as the liquor license is granted, and ending on April 30, 2010.
- Lease Contingent. The term of this Lease is contingent on the granting of a liquor license to the Tenant for the premises. If such liquor license is not granted then the Tenant may elect to cancel the Lease.
- Rent. The rent under this Agreement shall be \$1,500.00 per month. The rent shall be due on the first day of each month. Rent for any part of a month shall be prorated.
- Security Deposit. Tenant hereby agrees to pay a security deposit in the amount of \$1,500,00, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged.
- Option to Renew. Tenant shall have an option to renew the lease for an additional 6. term of two years. Said option shall be exercised by written notice to Landlord 90 days before the current lease terms ends. Landlord reserves the right to renegotiate the rent for the renewal.
