LOCAL DISASTER DECLARATION

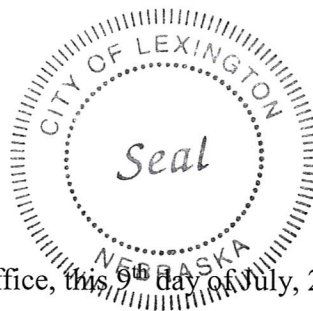
July 9, 2019

The City of Lexington, Nebraska has suffered from flooding that began on July 8, 2019 to current date causing severe damage to public and private property, disruption of utility service, and endangerment of health and safety of the citizens of the City of Lexington within the disaster area.

Therefore, the Mayor of the City of Lexington has declared a state of emergency authorized under Nebraska State Statute R.R.S. 81-829.50 on behalf of the City of Lexington, and will execute for and on behalf of the City of Lexington, the expenditure of emergency funds from all available sources, the invoking of mutual aid agreements, and the applying to the State of Nebraska for assistance from the Governor's Emergency Fund and any other resources he deems necessary in the fulfillment of his duties.
