

**CITY COUNCIL

March 10, 2026**

A Regular Meeting of the Lexington City Council was held Tuesday, March 10, 2026, in Lexington, Nebraska at 5:30 p.m. Members of the Council present were John Fagot, Dora Vivas, Jared Jacob and Jeremy Roberts. John Salem was absent. City Officials present were City Manager Joe Pepplitsch, Assistant City Manager Dennis Burnside, City Attorney Brian Copley, Finance Director Derek Haines and City Clerk Bill Brecks.
