Please take grass clippings, leaves, garden waste and tree limbs to the **★ YARD WASTE SITE ★** at 1201 E. Industry Drive

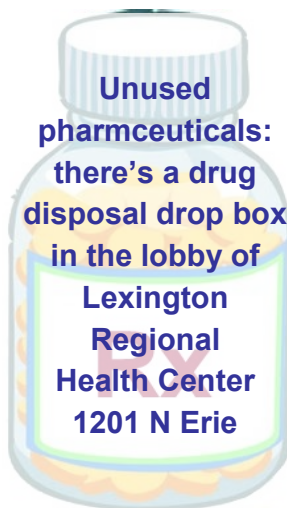
