

ORDINANCE NO. 2427

AN ORDINANCE TO SET PENALTIES FOR ANIMALS AND FOWL RUNNING AT LARGE; TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES OR SECTIONS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. SECTION 6-10 of the LEXINGTON CITY CODE IS HEREBY REPEALED AND REPLACED WITH THE FOLLOWING:

Any person who shall violate the provisions of Section 6-8 or Section 6-9 pertaining to animals or fowl running at large shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined \$25.00 for the first offense, \$50.00 for a second offense, and \$100.00 for the third offense and \$150.00 for each offense thereafter. These fines shall be in addition to any and all costs incurred by the City, including impoundment costs, and all other costs allowed by law.

Section 2. REPEAL

(a) That all ordinances or sections of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. PAMPHLET FORM

(a) That this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect as provided by law.
