

Councilman G. V. Keller offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

That General Obligation Hospital Bonds of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, of the principal amount of One Hundred Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$125,000), dated June 15, 1953, consisting of 125 bonds of One Thousand Dollars each, numbered 121 to 245, inclusive, are hereby called for payment on the fifteenth day of June, 1958, and that the County Treasurer is authorized and directed to pay said bonds with interest to said date.

It was moved by Councilman Judge and seconded by Councilman Delp that the above resolution be adopted, and on roll call the same was adopted by the following vote:
