

RESOLUTION OF ELECTION CANVASS

A Resolution finding and determining the results of Special Bond Election held in the City of Lexington, Nebraska, on April 22, 1958, for submission to the qualified voters of said City the proposition of authorizing the City Council of said City to issue its negotiable general obligation bonds in an amount of \$250,000.00 for the purpose of the Construction of a Sewage Treatment Works, Appurtenances and Sewer Lines of said City, to-wit: To construct a Sewage Treatment Plant and Trunk Lines, and the levy of a tax annually for the payment of principal and interest on said bonds.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA, sitting as a Board of canvassers, to canvass the returns of the Special Election held in the City of Lexington, Nebraska, on April 22, 1958, on the following proposition, to-wit:

"Shall the President of the Council and the Council of the City of Lexington, Nebraska issue the negotiable coupon bonds of said City in the sum of \$250,000.00 in denominations of \$1,000.00 each payable to bearer, bearing interest at the rate of not to exceed 4% per annum, payable semi-annually, to become due not less than five (5) years nor more than twenty (20) years from the date of issue, but redeemable after five (5) years from date of issue, for the purpose of the construction of sewage treatment works, appurtenances and sewer lines and to provide for a tax as may be necessary for the payment of the interest and principal thereon when it shall become due."

Section 1. We find and determine that said Special Election was in all respects regular and that the following vote was cast at said election For and Against said proposition, viz:


Section 2. We further find that the Affirmative of said proposition having received a majority of more than sixty (60%) per cent of the votes cast, and an actual majority of more than eighty-nine (89%) per cent, said proposition is carried, and it is hereby so declared.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the President of the Council and the Council of said City of Lexington, Nebraska, that we have fully canvassed the results of the Special Bond Election held in said city on April 22, 1958, upon the proposition above set forth, and we hereby find, declare and certify that said returns of election, as made by the several election boards are correct, and the affirmative of said proposition carried by a majority of 482 votes, and that total votes cast for the Affirmative of said proposition was more than 89% of the votes cast at said election.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council of said City proceed with the sale of the Bonds as authorized by said election, at the earliest practicable date.
