

R E S O L U T I O N


WHEREAS, The taxpayers of the City of Lexington have invested a substantial sum of money in land area, facilities and labor for the purpose of providing a means of disposing of normal household and commercial wastes, trash, discards and other refuse from the City of Lexington and

WHEREAS, it is deemed in the public interest to establish rules and regulations for the operation and use of the Refuse Disposal Area to the end that the maximum benefit shall be derived from the available space and the best possible appearance shall be maintained,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Lexington that

1. The Refuse Disposal Area shall be open for the use of the Public between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 7:00 P.M. on Week Days and between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 12:00 Noon on Sundays and Holidays.
2. The City Manager shall cause to be installed appropriate signs indicating the location and type of refuse which is to be deposited in various sections of the Refuse Disposal Area, and
3. When such signs are installed no person shall deposit refuse in the Area other than as directed by signs or by the Area Custodian.
4. No person shall deposit dead bodies or parts of dead bodies of animals or fowls, spoiled or unhatched eggs or similar odorous refuse above ground or in the water-fill area, but shall bury same under the supervision of and in a location designated by the Area Custodian.
5. No person shall salvage, move or remove any material or object of any kind which may have been deposited in the Refuse Disposal Area without first purchasing from the City Clerk a permit authorizing such salvage or removal. The Fee for such permit is hereby established as \$5.00 for each calendar month or fraction thereof and the money received therefore shall be deposited by the City Clerk in the fund of the City of Lexington.
6. The possession of a valid Scavenger's Permit shall not entitle the holder thereof to any prior right or claim to any material in the Refuse Disposal Area.
7. No materials salvaged from the Refuse Disposal Area may be returned to or kept within the corporate limits of the City of Lexington except in the establishment of an established junk Dealer.
8. No fires shall be lighted in the Refuse Disposal Area except by the Area Custodian or under his supervision.
