

R E S O L U T I O N


Whereas vehicular and pedestrian traffic in the City of Lexington, Nebraska, has increased to the point where congestion during peak hours and peak days is virtually unsupportable and,

Whereas some plan for regulating or directing said traffic must soon be adopted and,

Whereas the City of Lexington finds itself lacking in facilities to make surveys leading to such a plan,


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, that the City Manager be directed to request the assistance of the Department of Roads and Irrigation in conducting a survey and recommending a solution for the above problem, and that the City Manager present the results of the survey and the recommendation to the Planning Commission at the earliest possible date.
