

RESOLUTION TO PROVIDE FOR NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION

Be it resolved by the President of the Council and the Council of the City of Lexington, Nebraska:

Section 1. That the following notice of election be published as provided by Ordinance No. 722, to-wit:

Notice of Special Election.

Notice is hereby given that at a special election on Tuesday, June 28, 1955, between the hours of 8 o'clock a.m., and 8 o'clock p.m., at the usual voting places in the various wards of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, the following proposition shall be submitted to the electors of said City:

"Shall the President of the Council and the Council of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, sell to the Dawson County Public Power District, a public corporation of Lexington, Nebraska, approximately forty-two and one-half ($42\frac{1}{2}$) miles of rural electric distribution lines belonging to the City of Lexington, generally adjacent to the City of Lexington, (not including any of the urban system) for the sum of Thirty-six Thousand One Hundred Twenty-five (\$36,125.00) Dollars, as provided in Section 70-504, Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, Reissue of 1950."

The form in which said proposition shall be submitted shall be by ballot whereon shall be printed the above proposition and immediately below the same, the following:


"For the sale to the Dawson County Public Power District, a public corporation of Lexington, Nebraska, approximately forty-two and one-half ($42\frac{1}{2}$) miles of rural electric distribution lines belonging to the City of Lexington, generally adjacent to the City of Lexington, (not including any of the urban system) for the sum of Thirty-six Thousand One Hundred Twenty-five (\$36,125.00) Dollars, as provided in Section 70-504, Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, Reissue of 1950, Yes- ."

"Against the sale to the Dawson County Public Power District, a public corporation of Lexington, Nebraska, approximately forty-two and one-half ($42\frac{1}{2}$) miles of rural electric distribution lines belonging to the City of Lexington, generally adjacent to the City of Lexington, (not including any of the urban system) for the sum of Thirty-six Thousand One Hundred Twenty-five (\$36,125.00) Dollars, as provided in Section 70-504, Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, Reissue of 1950, No- ."

Section 2. That said notice shall be dated and signed by the President of the Council and City Clerk and shall be published in the Lexington Clipper and Dawson County Herald as provided in Ordinance No. 722.


Section 3. That the terms of the sale of said electric lines in the above notice are hereby adopted by the President of the Council and the Council as the terms of said sale, and said sale, when completed, shall conform in all respects to the Laws of the State of Nebraska, and the ordinance of the City of Lexington, Nebraska.
