

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, petitions have been filed for the creation of sewer districts on West 8th and West 10th streets west of Adams Street; and

WHEREAS, the City has for the past two years been attempting to work out an equitable dedication of streets and alleys in said area in order that the same might be properly served with sewer, water and other utilities; and


WHEREAS, the residents and property owners in said area have been unable to agree on such dedication of streets and alleys and the majority of such owners desire the City to condemn and purchase the right of way for streets and alleys; and

WHEREAS, the Council of said City does not consider that such condemnation would be an equitable procedure in view of the large amount which the City would be required to invest to serve said area with adequate water mains; and in view of the excessive cost which would be incurred by some properties to receive sewer and water service.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA.

1. That no action shall be taken by the City for the creation of Sewer Districts in said area west of Adams Street ^{on West 8th} and West 10th Streets, and that sewer districts shall be installed in said area only upon the establishment and dedication of approved streets and alleys for the proper service of such area at an equitable cost to the owners of real estate therein.
