WHEREAS, the City Treasurer of the City of Lexington, has on hand surplus funds in the amount of \$877.37, received from special assessments on Paving and Improvement Districts within said City which are not required for the payment of Bonds or Warrants of the said Districts:


Section 1. That the following surplus funds now on hand with said City Treasurer of the City of Lexington:

are not required for the payment of either Warrants, Bonds or other indebtedness charged against said Districts and such amounts are excess funds received by said City over and above the amount required for the payment of indebtedness charged against said Districts.


Section 2. That the total of the above excess funds in the amount of \$877.37 shall be paid by the City Treasurer to the County Treasurer to be credited to the Intersection paving account of the City of Lexington and to be used for the payment of interest and retirement of Intersection Paving Bonds of said City.
