

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, T. R. McGUIRE AND HELEN McGUIRE, of Lexington, Nebraska have made application under the name of "CITY CAB", to the President of the Council and Council of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, for permission to operate a taxi service in the City of Lexington, Nebraska, and

WHEREAS, the President of the Council and Council deem it is for public convenience and necessity that permission be granted to said "CITY CAB" to operate as a taxi service and use the streets and alleys of the City of Lexington, Nebraska.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:
